Retrofit Chardonnay 2015

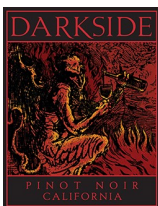

Darkside Pinot Noir



A lush nose of dark cherry, fresh raspberry, and cranberry with hints of cinnamon, clove, tobacco leaf, lavender and dark chocolate. Flavors of red fruits including pomegranate and sour cherry are accented by wisps of coffee and a hint of cedar. This well-balanced wine has a bright acidity, firm tannins, and a creamy mid-palate.

Paxis "Bulldog" Red Blend 2013

A delicious wine. Although the palate is quite concentrated, it presents a surprisingly gentle nature. This wine is medium-bodied and brimming with aromas of black cherries, raspberries and the spicy notes. The finish is elegant and persistent.
